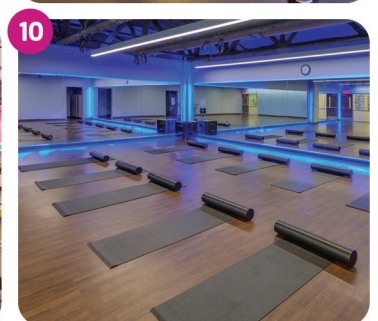
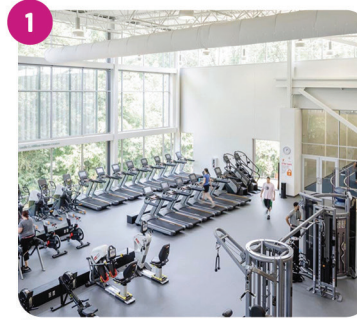

KEY FEATURES OF THE NEW FACILITY

- 1 Two-Level Wellness Center:** state-of-the-art 6,000+ square foot Wellness Center on the main level to include cardio and strength training equipment; and a functional training space on the 3rd floor
- 2 Youth Learning Center:** dedicated space to provide academic enrichment opportunities for children, as well as collaborative space for community partners
- 3 Community Center:** large multi-purpose space for special programming, educational classes, social activities and meetings
- 4 Teen Center:** dedicated space for safe and structured programming for teens
- 5 Kids Adventure Zone:** interactive 2-story play area for children ages 5–12
- 6 Child Watch Area:** infants through 5-year-olds will be in high-quality care during your visit to the Y
- 7 Teaching Kitchen:** a new cornerstone to the Y's commitment to a healthy living lifestyle will include instructional cooking classes for all ages
- 8 Arts Studio:** intergenerational space for art and creative enrichment opportunities
- 9 Group Exercise Studios:** exciting new spaces for various group exercise classes and programs
- 10 Yoga & Pilates Studio:** dedicated studio to enrich the spirit, mind and body
- 11 Universal Locker Rooms:** additional private changing and showering rooms

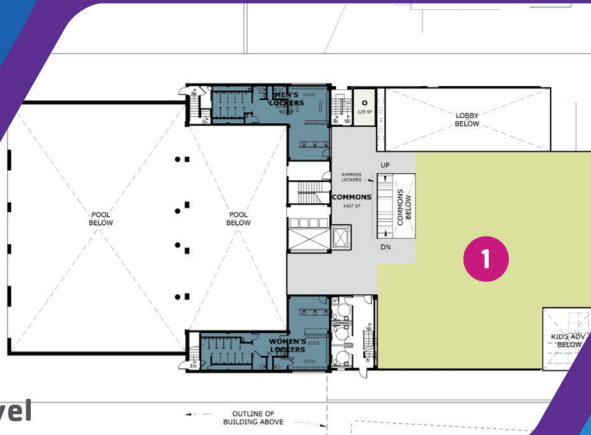

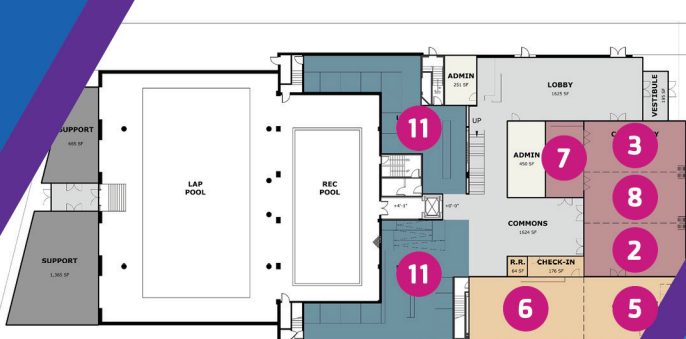
